

Instructions for authors

The authors must send their manuscripts electronically on the www.e-journal.in after registering their details in the website. The manuscript must be written in British English, as Word document (extension doc. or .rtf). Review papers are limited to 25 pages. Regular papers are limited to 12 pages. Short communications are limited to 6 pages and short breaking news notes are limited to 3 pages. Every manuscript must have an abstract with maximum 200 words. Figures and Tables are recommended to be introduced in the text with their legends.

The following structure of the paper is recommended:

1. Introduction
2. Experimental (Theory, Modeling)
3. Results
4. Discussion
5. Conclusions
